Aquiles Suarez is the Vice President for Government Affairs for NAIOP, the Commercial Real Estate Development Association, where he oversees the association's advocacy efforts at the federal, state and local level, and manages the association's political action committee, NAIOP-PAC. Aquiles has been with NAIOP leading its government affairs efforts since 2007.

Before joining NAIOP, Aquiles held several positions in the executive and legislative branches:

- He served as Special Assistant for Domestic Policy to President George W. Bush, and was a member of the White House Domestic Policy Council. He worked on issues such as welfare reform, veteran's healthcare issues, housing, and economic development;
- He was a senior counsel on the Financial Services Committee of the House of Representatives;
- He served as an attorney in the White House Counsel's Office, for President George H.W. Bush;
- He started his public service career working as a political appointee at the Department of Housing and Urban Development, for then HUD Secretary Jack Kemp.

Aquiles has practiced real estate and corporate law in Miami, Florida, and Washington, D.C. He is a graduate of Georgetown University and Columbia University Law School.
